- o Finance =\$1804.36 in Riders checking account.
- o Sickcall- SAL Commander, Rick's mother will begin radiation treatments for 6 weeks.
- o Memberships are due. Legion dues are \$40, SAL is \$25, and Auxiliary is 30.
- The chapter visited Ft Sill to deliver presents and gift card to our adopted family and met some Active Duty soldiers who happened to be at the center. The Dep0loyed father is due back in January.
- o The chapter visited the Norman Vet center and dropped off \$630 dollars in presents for the residents.
- The chapter donated house shoes to the military residents at the Warr Acres Nursing Center and we have been asked to visit again in February, no date as of yet.
